**SUNONE SOLUTIONS: North America's #1 Carbon Aggregator Relocates Headquarters to Colorado**

This past summer the U.S. House of Representatives passed the American Clean Energy and Security Act which would establish a federal carbon credit market. The U.S. Senate is expected to consider a similar bill this Spring. The legislative process has made it clear that agriculture will be recognized for the contributions it has and can make to sequester greenhouse gases through conservation practices. In addition, several state governments, including Colorado's,

and the U.S. Department for Agriculture are taking the lead on localized efforts to provide incentives towards reductions in carbon emissions.

SunOne Solutions is a member on the Chicago Climate Exchange (CCX) and the California Climate Action Reserve (CAR), and also works with the Voluntary Carbon Standard (VCS) and the American Carbon Registry (ACR). In addition to its Colorado Headquarters, the Company has offices in Alabama, Brazil, California, Nebraska, and is in the process of opening a Texas Office.
